The **Institute of Urban and Territorial Studies** (Instituto de Estudios Urbanos y Territoriales – IEUT) of the **Pontifical Catholic University of Chile** (Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile) is opening two Profesor/Researcher full-time positions (44 hours/week).

Position Description

The call is for candidates with consolidated experience in academic research and teaching in one or more of the following areas: **Urban Planning Theory, Urban Economics, and Mobility**.

Candidates should demonstrate a strong academic trajectory and scientific productivity, with publications in high impact journals, allocation of research funds from national and/or international funds, interdisciplinary collaboration in any of the fields of this call, national and international cooperation networks, among others, as well as knowledge regarding the academic project of the Institute of Urban and Territorial Studies.

Candidates must demonstrate experience in the guidance of undergraduate and graduate level thesis, as well as teaching experience at both levels. The latest student evaluations should be included in the application. Candidate must have fluency in Spanish, both written and spoken.

The workload distribution will be agreed with the Chair of the IEUT and will include teaching, research, and academic management tasks. The distribution will be reviewed annually, according to the needs of IEUT.

It is required to be in possession of a Ph.D. degree in areas related to urban planning, urban economy or mobility. The academic category and remuneration will be settled according to the criteria of the Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile, based on the candidate's experience and curricular background.

- Demonstrate a strong academic research trajectory

- Demonstrate experience in undergraduate and graduate level teaching, as well as experience in thesis guidance for both undergraduate and graduate levels.
- Demonstrate academic experience and/or specialization in one of the following areas:
 - Urban Planning Theory
 - Urban Economy
 - Mobility
- Fluency in Spanish (spoken and written)

Documents for Application

- Curriculum Vitae with an emphasis on teaching and research experience, and publications.
- Statement of Purpose (or Letter of Interest) – Three pages maximum.
 - A brief description of academic and professional career.
 - Proposal for academic insertion in the department, specifying the area of development in research.
 - Teaching proposal for undergraduate and graduate levels
 - Academic projection
- Two letters of reference and specific recommendation for this call for applications.
- Copies of Academic and Professional Degree Certificates
- Certificate of student evaluations for the last four semesters
- Any other documents considered necessary.

Selection Criteria

- Academic degrees and letters of reference
- Academic experience in the specified areas (Urban Planning Theory, Urban Economics, and Mobility)
- Quality of scholarly production and teaching experience.
- Feasibility of development and insertion in the Faculty of Architecture, Design and Urban Studies.
- Cooperation and research networks (national and international).
- Pre-selected Candidates will be interviewed and asked to make a presentation.
