Selection process for postdoctoral research grant

The 'Production of Space and Regional Redefinitions' Research Group (GAsPERR), of the School of Science and Technology, of the São Paulo State University (UNESP), Presidente Prudente campus, Brazil, welcomes applicants for three (03) postdoctoral research grants, for those willing to contribute to the activities of the thematic project 'Socio-Spatial Fragmentation and Brazilian Urbanization: Scales, Vectors, Rhtyhms, Form and Content' (FragUrb), with focus on the themes 'Center, centrality and mobility', 'Spatial practices and the everyday', and 'Housing sociospatial fragmentation, production and consumption'.

Each of the three (03) postdoctoral grants will be awarded for twelve (12) months. In accordance with the conditions of the award, the grant holder will be replaced in the event of departure or performance incompatible with the expectations outlined in the workplan. The successful candidate will receive a monthly grant of R\$8,479.20 (Brazilian reais), as well as moving expenses and a research fund to cover costs directly incurred during research activities (in line with the index used by FAPESP, available at http://www.fapesp.br/rt).

During the grant, the successful candidate must live in Presidente Prudente, São Paulo state, Brazil, and conduct research activities in the 'Production of Space and Regional Redefinitions' Research Group (GASPERR) work facilities, at the UNESP campus, in Presidente Prudente. Furthermore, while fieldwork is less frequent at the current stage of the project, the successful candidate must be available for occasional trips to the studied areas, should they be necessary.
